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TSX and Dow Jones finish turbulent week on a positive footing

Higher mining and energy stocks sent the Toronto stock market ahead yesterday for a second-straight session.

American markets made strong gains during the course of a shortened session following the U.S. Thanksgiving holiday as traders returned to work in a buying mood amid hopes for a strong performance by retailers as the year-end shopping season began.

"From a technical basis, I think you can see either a sideways move or a bit of moving up because it's gone down so much so quickly," said Paul Harris of Avenue Investment Management.

Toronto's S&P/TSX composite index finished up 86.20 points to 13,467.20 on top of a 100-point gain Thursday. Advances beat declines 1,021 to 556 with 222 unchanged as 330.7 million shares traded worth \$4.4 billion.

The TSX lost 63.13 points during the week, the third-consecutive week of losses. It's still up 4.3 per cent since the beginning of 2007.

The TSX Venture Exchange added 54.92 points to 2,846.71.

The Canadian dollar was down 0.52 of a cent (U.S.) to \$1.0105.

DOW GAINS 181 POINTS

On Wall Street, the Dow industrials closed up 181.84 points at 12,980.88, with advances led by financial stocks that had tumbled lately on huge credit-related writedowns.

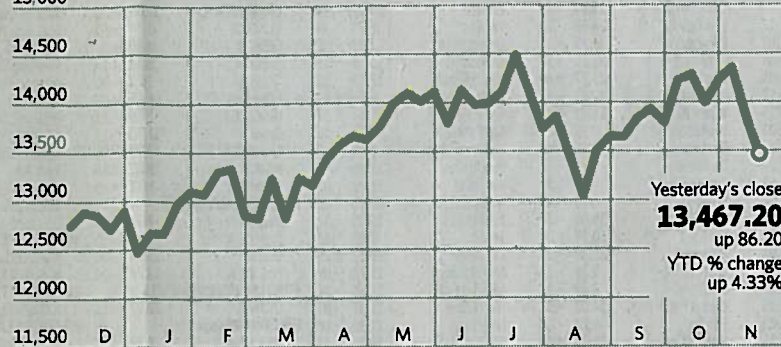
